Increased societal attention to the use and abuse of alcohol makes it imperative that Madison Area Technical College (MATC) only allows the responsible use of alcohol on campus. MATC may grant a permit for serving beer and/or wine at MATC District facilities to MATC affiliated groups or outside organizations providing written permission is received and all college procedures are followed. Sponsoring groups will be responsible for being aware of and adhering to all applicable state laws, municipal ordinances, and MATC procedures. Organizations sponsoring the event will assume all responsibility for damages to the facility and indemnify Madison Area Technical College from any loss, damage or injury resulting from the serving of beer and/or wine. Permission to serve beer and/or wine on MATC property in no way implies that MATC promotes the use of alcohol or will assume any liability for loss, damage, or injury resulting from the serving of beer and/or wine.
