Both instructors and students have a right to an educational environment that is conducive to learning. It is the responsibility of instructors to create and maintain this environment in individual classes. If individual students engage in behavior that is destructive of this educational environment, it may be necessary for them to be removed, temporarily or permanently, from the class. Such students, however, have a right to due process procedures to ensure fair treatment in such circumstances. Behaviors which are destructive of the educational environment include activities such as harassment and preventing other students from completing their educational assignments.
