The primary educational mission of Madison Area Technical College is the delivery of instruction and support services to the postsecondary student and for the adult vocational need of the District.

Educational services will be provided by the district to serve the needs of high school age youth within statutory and fiscal limitations. Legislation provides for specific access of high school age youth to WTCS classes both under the Compulsory Law Program (Wis. Stats. 118.15) and the Youth Options Program (Wis. Stats. 118.55).

High school students under the age of eighteen not enrolling in a statutory program may still enroll in classes with the permission of their parents or guardians. Registration of such students will be made on a space available basis.
