Madison Area Technical College recognizes that business and industry within the district compete in an increasingly global and international economy. Therefore, it is important for the college to reflect in its program and services, the social, political, cultural, and economic dimensions of this global environment.

In addition, students need to develop an understanding and appreciation of the international marketplace, either from personal experience in a multi-cultural society, or through an appreciation of the implications of politics, economics, and technology in different parts of the world. Therefore, where appropriate, instructional programs will incorporate an international dimension.

The District will engage in such international activities if such activities meet both of the following two conditions:

- A. The activities support the mission and vision of the college
- B. The activities do not hinder the college's ability to respond to institutional priorities, given finite resources.
